For the contest, there is a total of 10 finale contestants were chosen from over hundreds of contestants. In addition, the Shima Seiki Award winners will receive a one-week internship offered by Shima Seiki (Hong Kong) Limited. And the internship will be held at the headquarters of Wakayama, Japan. Of course, the flight ticket and the accommodation are also included in the reward. The prizes for the Best Use of Australian Merino Wool Award winners are also attractive. The winner can get a seven-to ten-day trip to Australia for a round-trip airfare and free accommodation, he can learn more about using wool during this time.
